Condition Report

In worn condition. Multiple chips and cracks to the mosaic section. One section of coral is missing. Should be five strings. Slight abrasions to the coral sections. Some claws either missing or bent from the coral sections on the clasp. One coral part has been replaced/glued in and is badly chipped.
