Condition Report

No key to test if this is in working condition at the present time. Inner case is scratched with dents to the reverse. Paint bubbled and cracked on the hour markers. Dial scratched. Both hands intact. Outer case in generally worn condition. Release button is dented. Outer case weighs 24.7g
