AN EARLY TWENTIETH CENTURY DIAMOND THREE STONE RING

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the central diamond of approximately 1.18 carats, flanked by two smaller diamonds of approximately 0.65 carats each, marked PLATINUM, size N 1/2, 3.8g

Condition Report

Centre stone = very approximately 7.5x5mm.

Side stones = very approximately 5.5x4mm.

In worn condition, generally scratched.

To the naked eye:

Noticeable grey tint to the stones, mainly the centre stone.

No inclusions visible.

Under magnification:

Very slight white pinpoint inclusions visible in each stone.

Stones abraded and slightly chipped to the girdle.

Paste like substance underneath setting.

Claws generally worn.

All stones intact.
