Condition Report

GENTLEMAN'S:

Ticking at the present time.

In heavily worn condition.

Case scratched and dented.

Dial and acrylic heavily discoloured.

All hands intact.

Crown intact; doesn't sit flush to the case. Hands changing.

PANTHER:

Not in working condition at the present time - has been overwound.

In well worn condition.

Scratched and discoloured.

Acrylic scratched.

Dial marked.

All hands and markers intact.

Crown discoloured; hands able to change.

Strap worn and discoloured.

Clasp in working order.

BENSON:

Ticking at the present time.

Case scratched and dented.

Acrylic scratched.

Dial spotted and discoloured.

All hands and markers intact.

Tip of the minute hand rusted.

Bracelet twisted.
